Planning and Building Director Derrick Braaten presented the following background. On April 30, 2019, the BoCC heard an appeal (Appeal 2019-01), brought by Lynn J. Olsen, of the preliminary approval for Short Plat application (SP 2019-03). The BoCC continued the hearing to May 21, 2019. Prior to the May 21st meeting, the parties in the dispute continued working to reach agreement on the matter. As these discussions continued, both parties requested the hearing be postponed to give the parties time to reach agreement, or until it was determined by the parties that an agreement could not be reached. On July 17, 2019, staff received notice all parties had reached agreement, and was provided a signed copy of the agreed upon terms. The recommendation is to declare appeal 2019-01 to be moot, as all parties in the dispute have reached agreement regarding the issues of appeal, as provided for in the attached agreement.
