BACKGROUND: During the 2020 budget process, the HR Director requested to restructure the HR Department for 2020, ultimately resulting in a reduction of staff by one full-time employee. Existing employees in the two affected HR positions were notified of the requested restructure in August 2019 when the preliminary budget was submitted for the department.						
Both affected employees have found other employment, necessitating a request to implement the restructure a few weeks early to allow for the hire of a new employee to maintain necessary HR staffing levels and avoid disruption of HR services for the rest of 2019.
