SUBJECT: Resolution to Approve Local Agency Project Prospectus and enter into a Local Agency Agreement for CRP 624 / LED Signs, Dynamic Signals and Reflector Posts project.		
FISCAL IMPACT: Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Highw \$310,900 for the safety countermeasures on pre-	vay Safety Improvement Programs (HSIP) has awarded eselected county roads.	
Preliminary Engineering (PE) for this project is \$26,200 (\$23,600 FHWA grant; \$2,600 County Funds).		
The estimated cost for the total project is \$313,000.		
BACKGROUND: Public Works submitted three (3) safety projects for grant funding through the 2019 FHWA Highway Safety Improvement Programs (HSIP) call for projects. All three (3) of which were awarded HSIP grant funds. CRP 624 / Safety - LED Signs, Dynamic Signals and Reflector Posts project's scope of work is to install/upgrade signs (LED Stop Ahead warning signs), install dynamic intersection warning signs (Entering Traffic When Flashing), install radar speed signs, and install/upgrade signs (Stop signs) and reflector posts at various predetermined locations throughout the County. The proposed safety project aims to reduce both roadway departures and intersection accidents. At this time, Public Works ask to approve the required submittals of the Project Prospectus and enter into a Local Agency Agreement to begin the Preliminary Engineering (PE) funding for this safety project. The Local Agency Agreement request \$23,600 of federal funds with a county match of \$2,600. RECOMMENDATION: Approve attached Resolution, Project Prospectus, and Local Agency Agreement between Franklin		
County and Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT).
