SUBJECT: Resolution Initiating a County Road Project (CRP) 627 - Glade North Road Pavement Rehabilitation I	
FISCAL IMPACT: Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBG) has awarded Franklin County \$108,125 towards the preliminary engineering portion of the proposed CRP 627 - Glade North Road Pavement Rehabilitation I project. The grant requires a 13.5% match of \$16,875 for a total of \$125,000. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• This proposed project is included in the 2020 Annual Construction Program.• The estimated total project cost is \$1,550,000.	
BACKGROUND: Public Works submitted the Glade North Road Pavement Rehabilitation I project for preliminary grant funding through Benton-Franklin Council of Governments 2019 call for projects. In 1996, the County upgraded Glade North Road from Pasco City Limits to Selph Landing Road to an all-weather section of roadway. This section of roadway was one of many major arterial routes that were constructed to an all-weather route. Although the County has been proactive in preserving and maintaining these and other roads through routine crack seal and chip seal programs, a major rehabilitation is necessary to reset the clock on the pavement's expiration. CRP 627 - Glade North Road Pavement Rehabilitation I project aims to rehabilitate 1.63 miles of Glade North Road from the Pasco City Limits to Clark Road. Work will include asphalt milling (or other similar strategy), asphalt overlay, and other enhancements that are warranted. Through routine evaluation of the condition of the County's roads, the proposed project is the first of many future projects to address the need to rehabilitate the County's existing all-weather system. At this time, Franklin County has only secured funding for the preliminary engineering phase. The proposed project is a good candidate for upcoming funding for the construction phase. Public Works ask to initiate a County Road Project for Glade North Road Pavement Rehabilitation I.

***INITIATING A COUNTY ROAD PROJECT DESIGNATED AS
CRP 627 – GLADE NORTH ROAD PAVEMENT REHABILITATION I***

WHEREAS, the County has received funding from Federal Highway Transportation (FHWA) Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBG) for the rehabilitation to a section of Glade North Road.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT Glade North West Road (09010) from Pasco City Limits (MP 0.32) to Intersection of Clark Road (MP 2.04) be improved as follows:

Pavement overlay and add illumination as needed.

This project is hereby declared to be a public necessity and the County Engineer is hereby ordered and authorized to report and proceed thereon as by law provided. (RCW 36.75.050, 36.80.030, 36.80.070).

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that an appropriation from the 2020 officially adopted road fund budget and based on the County Engineer's estimate is hereby made in the amounts and for the purposes shown.
