FRANKLIN COUNTY RESOLUTION

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, WASHINGTON

IN THE MATTER OF EXPANSION OF THE EMERGENCY HOUSING PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE BENTON AND FRANKLIN COUNTIES DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES DUE TO COVID 19.

WHEREAS, the Benton and Franklin Counties Department of Human Services administers the Emergency Housing Program for Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, the ongoing COVID 19 pandemic has created unprecedented need for assistance to the Community to ensure financial stability and stable housing; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide such stability, the Board of Franklin County Commissioners, wish to expand the Emergency Housing Program to assist residents of Franklin County during the COVID 19 pandemic with rent payments, utility payments and other housing needs; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Housing Program expansion is between June 2, 2020 and December 31, 2020 in an amount up to \$85,000; and

WHEREAS, the funding for the expansion of the program may come from the Homeless Housing Fund number 188, which has funds in its reserve but had not intended to spend them this budget cycle, or a new revenue source such as a Grant, or a combination of both; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Franklin County Commissioners, Franklin County, Washington, approve the expansion of the Emergency Housing Program administered by the Benton and Franklin Counties Department of Human Services due to COVID 19; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Emergency Housing Program expansion term is between June 2, 2020 and December 31, 2020; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Emergency Housing Program expansion amount is up to \$85,000.
