**FISCAL IMPACT:** All costs associated with this project will be paid through the 2020 Helping Americans Vote Act (HAVA) grant received by the County Auditor's Office through the Washington State Secretary of State.

**BACKGROUND:** The County Auditor's office received a 2020 Helping Americans Vote Act (HAVA) grant through the Washington State Secretary of State to be utilized for enhancement to the safety and access of the Elections Building.

Pursuant to RCW 39.04.155, government agencies are allowed to utilize the small public works process for work estimated to be less than \$300,000.00. In accordance with RCW 39.04.155 and Franklin County purchasing policy, Resolution 2014-434, the Information Services Department, on behalf of the Auditor's Office, contacted approximately 95 vendors on the MRSC small works roster for Franklin County by email in order to obtain quotations for equipment, installation, and configuration of access control readers at our Franklin County Elections Office.

Of all the vendors contacted, only one responsive bid was received by Advanced Protection Services, Inc. of Pasco, Washington in the total bid amount of \$51,423.62, sales tax included, and

After careful review of the bid documents, the Information Services department has deemed the bid to be fair and in the best interest of Franklin County.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends the Franklin County Board of Commissioners award the contract to Advanced Protection Services, Inc.
