SUBJECT: Public Hearing for the Vacation of right of way dedicated for future W. Dradie Street

FISCAL IMPACT: Chapter 12.08 of the Franklin County Code would govern this vacation. All costs incurred in the investigation would be at the expense of the petitioners including time spent in the examination and reporting and all advertising costs. Pursuant to Chapter 12.08, reimbursements are paid into the County Road fund.

BACKGROUND

On November 10th, 2020, the Public Works office received a petition signed by seven (7) landowners living within the vicinity of W. Dradie Street requesting that the right of way dedicated for future W. Dradie Street be vacated. The petition was accompanied by a sufficient bond as required by law.

On December 15th, 2020, pursuant to Chapter 12.08.010 of the Franklin County Code, the Board accepted the petition and ordered the County Engineer to report thereon, and the County Engineer has completed said report and presented it to the Board.

A public hearing was scheduled for March 16th, 2021 in order to consider said vacation. Notice of the hearing was advertised in accordance with the law on January 21st, 2021, and February 18th, 2021 in the official newspaper of the County. Additionally a notice of the hearing was posted at the termini of the proposed vacation on January 20th, 2021.

If the Board decides to approve the vacation it must signify its intent with a resolution, one has been prepared for the Board's use if this course of action is desired.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Board take <u>no action</u> on the petition to vacate the right of way dedicated for future W. Dradie Street. This will maintain the easement for future use.

SUGGESTED MOTION: No motion is required. Only consensus of the Board not to take action on the Resolution. If the Board wish to move forward with the vacation, then the following is the suggested motion: I hereby move that the Board of Franklin County Commissioners approve the resolution issuing the Final Order of Vacation of right of way dedicated for future W. Dradie Street.

WHEREAS, a public hearing to consider said vacation was held on March 16th, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Franklin County Commissioners constitutes the legislative authority of Franklin County and finds said right-of-way is considered to be useless and the public will be benefited by its vacation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Franklin County Board of Commissioners, hereby orders that the portion of W. Dradie Street, as described in Exhibit A attached hereto, be vacated; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in accordance with RCW 36.87.140, that the county retain an easement in respect to the vacated land for the construction, repair, and maintenance of public utilities and services, which at the time the resolution is adopted are authorized, or are physically located on a portion of the land vacated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in accordance with Chapter 12.08.060 of the Franklin County Code, the cost and expense incurred by the County in the examination of this petition shall be paid by the petitioners and that, upon certification from the County treasurer that said costs and expenses have been so paid, the Board of County Commissioners shall declare the right-of-way vacated and enter its declaration in the Board minutes.

Table of Contents

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Background

The portion of *Dradie Street* under consideration was established by the Board of Commissioners via resolution 2003-223 on April 21st, 2003 as part of Short Plat No. 2003-06 with a dedicated 30 feet of right-of-way and a 50 foot radius cul-de-sac located south of the northern boundary line. (See Appendix B)

On November 10th, 2020, the Public Works office received a petition signed by the landowners adjoining Dradie Street requesting that a portion of Dradie Street be vacated. The petition was accompanied by a cash bond as required (see Appendix "A" for a copy of the petition).

On December 15th, 2020, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners, by Resolution No. 2020-284, ordered the County Engineer to report on the possible vacation of a portion of Dradie Street so that Board may consider the usefulness of such road.

Findings

The portion of *Dradie Street* under consideration begins at the easterly edge of the cul-de-sac and continues easterly for approximately 200 feet, terminating at the east property line of lot 4, Short Plat 2003-06.

It is my opinion that the portion of the right-of-way on *Dradie Street* under consideration should be retained by the County for the following reasons:

- Water and Sewer services are in close proximity to that area. Water services are available from Road 48, while sewer services are available on Road 44. (See Appendix D for maps of current water and sewer locations)
- Franklin PUD and Charter Cable already utilize the easement for services.
- The extension of Dradie Street would also be a logical connection between Road 44 and Road 48.
- Vacating the existing right-of-way could negatively impact future development in the area.

The Public Works Department contacted utility providers and the City of Pasco requesting input on potential impacts to their facilities (see Appendix "C" for comments received from interested parties). Franklin PUD and Charter Cable indicated that an easement be retained for their currents services. Lumen (formerly CenturyLink), and the Franklin County Irrigation District indicated that the vacation of that portion of *Dradie Street* would have no significant impact on their operations or facilities. The City of Pasco indicated opposition to vacation based on similar reasons as stated above.

Recommendations

The County Engineer recommends that the Board of County Commissioners take no action on the vacation of the above-mentioned Dradie Street, as petitioned. This will maintain the right-of-way easement as dedicated.
