SUBJECT: Resolution to Execute the contract provisions and plans for County Road Project (CRP) 625 / Safety - Guardrail/Curve Improvements at Blanton Road, R-170, and Columbia River Road project to Construction Ahead dba Pavement Surface Control of Kennewick, Washington.	
FISCAL IMPACT: Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Highway Safety Improvement Programs (HSIP) has awarded \$273,305 towards the construction phase of CRP 625 / Safety - Guardrail/Curve Improvements at Blanton Road, R-170, and Columbia River Road. The project is included in the 2021 Annual Construction & Major Equipment Purchases (Resolution 2020-290).	
BACKGROUND: CRP 625 / Safety – Guardrail/Curve Improvements at Blanton Road, R-170, and Columbia River Road project's scope of work is to install/upgrade permanent signing, pavement markings, rumble strips, and guardrail. The proposed safety project aims to reduce roadway departures. On November 9 th , the Board of County Commissioners awarded the above-mentioned contract to Construction Ahead dba Pavement Surface Control (PSC) for \$256,029.50 excluding sales tax. Public Works is prepared to execute the contract for the construction of CRP 625 / Safety - Guardrail/Curve Improvements at Blanton Road, R-170, and Columbia River Road project.

CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT, MADE AND ENTERED INTO THIS _____ day of _____, 2021, between the *COUNTY OF FRANKLIN*, acting through the *BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS*, under and by virtue of Title 47 RCW as amended, and _____ hereinafter called the Contractor.

WITNESSETH, this in consideration of the terms and conditions contained herein and attached and made a part of this agreement, the parties hereto covenant and agree as follows:

- I. The Contractor shall do all work and furnish all tools, materials, and equipment for **CRP 625 / Safety – Guardrail/Curve Improvements At Blanton Road, R-170, and Columbia River Road**, in accordance with and as described in the attached plans and specifications and the Standard Specifications of the Washington State Department of Transportation, which are by this reference incorporated herein and made part hereof, and shall perform any changes in the work in accord with Contract Documents.

The Contractor shall provide and bear the expense of all equipment, work, and labor of any sort whatsoever that may be required for the transfer of materials and for constructing and completing the work provided for in these Contract Documents, except those items mentioned therein to be furnished by the County of Franklin.

- II. The County of Franklin hereby promises and agrees with the Contractor to employ and does employ the Contractor to provide the materials and to do and cause to be done the above-described work, and to complete and finish the same in accord with the attached plans, specifications, and terms and conditions herein contained; and, hereby contracts to pay for the same according to the attached specifications and the schedule of unit or itemized prices at the time, in the manner, and upon the conditions provided for in this contract.
- III. The Contractor for himself/herself, and for his/her heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns does hereby agree to the full performance of all the covenants required of the Contractor in the contract.
- IV. It is further provided that no liability shall attach the County by reason of entering into this contract, except as expressly provided herein.
