**BACKGROUND:** It has become a serious challenge to find replacement fleet patrol vehicles because of global supply chain disruptions arising from the pandemic. The Sheriff's office had previously ordered 2 Ford F-150 Patrol vehicles which were cancelled by the manufacturer, and currently have 2 Ford Explorer Patrol vehicles on order with no status of when they might be completed, if at all. Furthermore, the current patrol vehicles are experiencing many maintenance issues because of high mileage.

The Sheriff's Office has the opportunity to purchase 8 Chevy Tahoes to add to the fleet. In doing so will release the following vehicles to start the county vehicle pool.
