SUBJECT: Award of Bid for the construction of County Road Maintenance Project (CRMP) 2020-002 –Burr Canyon Guardrail Replacement project to Frank Gurney, Inc of Spokane Valley, Washington.			
FISCAL IMPACT:			

Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and Washington State Military Department has awarded \$902,322.97 towards the CRMP 2020-002 Burr Canyon Guardrail Replacement project. Franklin County Public Works will pay 12.5% of the eligible non-federal share of approximately \$128,903.28.

Total estimated cost for this project is \$1,031,226.25 including staff's time. Public Works has funds in the 2023 County Road's budget for the 12.5% match.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

On September 7, 2020, Franklin County experienced fires that required response by emergency services and the Public Works Department. Said fires required the long-term closures of both Burr Canyon Road and Wallace Walker Road, due to extensive damage to overhead railroad trestles, destroying the deck to a small box culvert, and destroying guardrail.

The Board of Commissioners made a Declaration of A County Emergency on October 6th, 2020 per Resolution 2020-213. Governor Jay Inslee amended Proclamation 20-68 to include multiple fires that occurred during Labor Day. The President of the United States proclaimed a major disaster existed in Washington State (FEMA 4584 DR-WA). The proclamation by the President allowed the Governor to request public assistance through the FEMA; which allowed Franklin County to request for assistance emergency funding.

The project's scope of work is to replace a 13,510 LF' of guardrail, guardrail post, and end terminals that were damaged or destroyed due to fires that occurred on Labor Day weekend 2020.

On December 15th & 22nd, an Invitation for the construction of this project was published in the Franklin County Graphic, Seattle Daily Journal, the Washington State's Office of Minority and Women's Business Enterprise (OMWBE) webpage, and the Franklin County's Public Works webpage, fulfilling both RCW 36.77.020 and federal grant requirements.

On January 11th, 2023, bids were opened for the construction of the above-mentioned project at the Public Works office. After opening and reading the four (4) bids, Public Works checked the proposals for correctness and accuracy and has determined the lowest responsive and responsible bidder to be Frank Gurney, Inc. of Spokane Valley for \$681,303.00 excluding sales tax.

**COORDINATION:** This agenda item was prepared under the supervision of Craig Erdman, Director/Engineer, and Duane Davidson, Interim County Administrator whom have concurred with our recommendation.

RECOMMENDATION: Execute Bid Award Letter awarding Frank Gurney, Inc. the contract for the construction of CRMP 2020-002- Burr Canyon Guardrail Replacement project.
