BACKGROUND: WAC136-150-021 requires that all Counties submit a certification showing the amount of the road levy fixed and the amount, if any, budgeted for traffic law enforcement and any other purpose from diverted road levy for the coming year no later than March 1st of each year.

The attached form shows the maximum allowable levy, subtracts the levy shift amount and establishes the actual road levy. The form also includes a line item for the estimated amount budgeted for Traffic Law Enforcement.

CRAB provides digital forms to submit this information. The information was completed by the Franklin County Assessor's Office and the County Engineer and will be submitted to CRAB. The digital form requires a hard copy certification signed by the County Engineer and the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners to be submitted to CRAB..
