SUBJECT:

Resolution Initiating a County Road Project (CRP) 635-Vineyard Drive West and North Railroad Avenue Intersection project.

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$2,142,900 of Washington State's Rural Arterial Trust Account's (RATA) grant funds through Rural Arterial Program (RAP) were requested through the County Road Administration Board (CRABoard) to be used towards the proposed Vineyard Drive West and North Railroad project. If approved, RATA funds will contribute \$1,529,800 towards the project from their '23-'24 funding cycle; there is a 10% local match requirement.

The remaining requested funds are expected to be awarded during the '25-'26 RAP funding cycle. The estimated cost for the proposed project is \$2,381,000 (\$2,142,900 RAP; \$238,100 Local Match)

The proposed project was added to the 2023-2028 County's Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) through Resolution 2022-243.

BACKGROUND:

September 20th, 2022, the Board of Commissioners approved Resolution 2022-232 approving the submittal of the Final Prospectus to the CRABoard for RAP funding for the Vineyard Drive West and North Railroad Avenue Intersection project.

The proposed project will address the intersection of Vineyard Drive West and North Railroad Avenue deficiencies with emphasis on Vineyard Drive West's site distance issues and truck turning movements. Besides not being structurally sound and sight distance issues, other deficiencies to this section of roadway is the width, need for turn lanes, edge cracking, longitudinal, transverse, and alligator cracking.

Proposed construction work to correct the above-mentioned deficiencies will include reconstruction of the intersection, additional turning lanes, hard surfacing, drainage, and safety enhancements. Completion of this project will construct an all-weather intersection for the continuation of a truck route, prolong the life of the roadway, improve ride, and enhance safety.

Public Works ask to initiate a County Road Project for Vineyard Drive West and North Railroad Avenue Intersection project.
