#### <u>Summary / Background Information</u>

Per Benton County Resolution No. 2022 769 dated October 25, 2022 and Franklin County Resolution No. 2022 254 dated October 11, 2022, the Board of Benton and Franklin County Commissioners entered into a contract with Apollo Mechanical Contractors to provide kitchen maintenance services for the Benton Franklin Counties Juvenile Justice Center.

The purpose of Amendment No. 1 is to amend Section 2 "Duration of Contract" to extend contract for one additional 12-month period and replace Section 5(b) "Compensation" to increase contract do not exceed limit.

Due to supply rate increase, the contract "do not exceed" limit will need to be increased by \$25,000 above the current contract amount of \$40,000; therefore, we are amending the contract to increase the do not exceed limit to \$65,000, excluding WSST.

The attached contract Amendment No. 1 shall commence on October 1, 2023 and shall expire on September 30, 2024.

# **Fiscal Impact**

Amount not to exceed of \$65,000, excluding WSST, will be paid out of Current Expense Dept. 172 Facilities Budget. No supplemental required.

# **Recommendation**

The Juvenile Administrator recommends that the Board of Commissioners of Benton County and the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County sign contract Amendment No. 1 between Apollo Mechanical Contractors and the Benton-Franklin Counties Juvenile Justice Center for services.

#### PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACT AMENDMENT NO. 1

This Contract Amendment is made and entered into by and between Benton County, a political subdivision, with its principal offices at 620 Market Street, Prosser, WA 99350 and Franklin County, a political subdivision, with its principal offices at 1016 North Fourth Avenue, Pasco, WA 99301, by and for the Benton-Franklin Counties Juvenile Justice Center, a bi-county agency located at 5606 W. Canal Place, Suite 106, Kennewick, WA 99336 (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Counties"), and Apollo Mechanical Contractors, with its principal offices at 1119 West Columbia Drive, Kennewick, WA 99336 (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor").

In consideration of the mutual benefits and covenants contained herein and in the parties' Contract, numbered as Benton County Resolution No. 2022 769 and executed on October 25, 2022, and Franklin County Resolution No. 2022 254 and executed on October 11, 2022, the parties agree to amend the Contract as follows:

- 1. Section 2 <u>DURATION OF CONTRACT</u>, "Upon mutual agreement of both parties, this Contract may be extended by written amendment for a maximum of one additional 12-month period." The term of the contract shall be extended for an additional 12-month period beginning on October 1, 2023 and shall expire September 30, 2024.
- 2. Section 5(b) COMPENSATION, shall be replaced in its entirety as follows:
  - b. The maximum total amount payable for the As-Needed Repairs by the COUNTIES to the CONTRACTOR under this Contract shall not exceed Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$65,000.00), excluding W.S.S.T. The CONTRACTOR shall monitor its cumulative total accounts receivables to ensure that it will not do work in excess of the maximum total amount payable set forth in this section and that its total billings will not exceed the maximum total amount payable. The CONTRACTOR shall inform the COUNTIES promptly in writing if the CONTRACTOR'S cumulative accounts receivable attributable to the COUNTIES, pursuant to this Contract, reaches eighty percent (80%) of the maximum total amount payable so that budgeting and approval of additional amounts may be obtained (if appropriate). Any dollar amount above the maximum total amount payable will only be approved with an amendment to this Contract.

Except as expressly provided in this Contract Amendment No. 1, all other terms and conditions of the original Contract remain in full force and effect.

This Amendment shall be effective on October 1, 2023.
