FISCAL IMPACT: Will depend on the total number of inspections performed and the value of each project inspected. However, this is a fee-for-service contract, charged at a rate of \$200 per hour, which is passed on to the applicant and paid at the time of permit issuance.						
BACKGROUND: As required under RCW 19.27.110, the Franklin County Building Department enforces the most recently adopted version of the International Fire Code (IFC), a subsection of the Washington State Building Code. As part of the enforcement of the IFC, the Building Department reviews building and structure plans to determine what fire/safety requirements a proposed use must include in the design and construction of said structure. Proper review of structural fire plans and the performance of fire inspections is a specialized service, and existing Building Department staff is currently working to become certified to perform such services. Andrew S. Klein has all certifications required to perform the services being requested.

Klein for the provision of building fire review and fire inspection services, as provided for in the attached contract.

RE: PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN FRANKLIN COUNTY AND ANDREW S. KLEIN, A CHEMICAL AND FIRE PROTECTION ENGINEER, FOR THE PROVISION OF FIRE PLAN REVIEW, FIRE INSPECTION SERVICES, AND FIRE PROTECTION DETERMINATIONS, FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE

WHEREAS, as required under RCW 19.27.110, the Franklin County Building Department enforces the most recently adopted version of the International Fire Code (IFC), a subsection of the Washington State Building Code; and

WHEREAS, as part of the enforcement of the IFC, the Building Department reviews building and structure plans to determine what fire/safety requirements a proposed use must include in the design and construction of said structure; and

WHEREAS, proper review of structural fire plans and the performance of fire inspections is a specialized service, and existing Building Department staff is currently working to become certified to perform such services; and

WHEREAS, Andrew S. Klein has all certifications required to perform the services being requested; and

WHEREAS, this contract is an on-call, fee-for-services contract, at a rate of \$200 per hour, to be paid by the applicant at time of permit issuance; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Planning and Building Department shall act as the designated agency to coordinate with, and determine what plans are reviewed by, Mr. Klein, in the performance of these services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C.W. 36.01.010 and R.C.W. 36.32.120 the legislative authority of each county is authorized to enter into contracts on behalf of the County and have the care of County property and management of County funds and business; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Franklin County Commissioners constitutes the legislative authority of Franklin County and desires to enter into this arrangement as being in the best interest of Franklin County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Franklin County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the attached Professional Services Agreement between Franklin County and Andrew S. Klein, to provide building fire plan review, fire protection determinations, and fire

inspection services, for Franklin County, and for those areas contracted with Franklin County for the provision of building services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Board of County Commissioners authorizes the Chair to sign the agreement, which shall become effective upon the date signed.

Scope of Services: This is a proposal for on-call, contracted, fire code enforcement for projects in Unincorporated Franklin County, including those jurisdictions that have building services contracts with Franklin County, such as the City of Connell, the City of Mesa, and the City of Kahlotus. Services include all functions that a building department's fire code plans examiner and fire code inspector are expected to perform. These include, without limitation, plans examinations and inspections to verify compliance with the Washington State Fire Code and any related work. All requests for service under this contract shall be generated by the Franklin County Planning & Building Department, and shall not be initiated by an applicant, unless notice is provided to A S Klein Engineering, PLLC by the Franklin County Building Official, in writing.

Cost for Services: Services as described in the Scope of Services, above, shall be charged at a rate of \$200/per hour.

Additional Services: Additional services beyond those described in the scope above and requested by the Client will be billed at \$200 per hour unless a fixed-fee arrangement is agreed to in writing. Expenses will be billed at cost.

Terms and Conditions: Terms and conditions are set forth on Page 2.

Terms and Conditions

The following are the applicable terms and conditions between **A S Klein Engineering**, PLLC and *Franklin County* (CLIENT) for consulting services:

- 6.
