Commissioners' Proceedings for February 3, 2010

The Honorable Board of Franklin County Commissioners met on the above date. Present for the meeting were Brad Peck, Chairman; and Rick Miller, Chair Pro Tem; Fred Bowen, County Administrator; and Mary Withers, Clerk to the Board. Bob Koch, Member, was absent on personal business. Meeting convened at 9:00 am. Present in audience: <u>Tri-City Herald</u> Reporter Kristy Pihl.

Secretary Bridgette Scott met with the Board.

Consent Agenda

<u>Motion</u> - Mr. Miller: Mr. Chairman, I move that we accept the consent agenda as listed. Second by Mr. Peck with discussion on item #2. After discussion, the Board agreed to approve item #2, followed by immediate update of the Veterans Assistance policy. 2:0 vote in favor.

- 1. Approval of Resolution 2010-033, cancellation of uncollectable personal property tax in the amount of \$4191.18 as identified in the December 2009 list received from the Franklin County Treasurer.
- 2. Approval of Veterans' Assistance Fund Waiver Request from the Veterans Advisory Board and the Franklin County Auditor's Office for a veteran whose income is \$1243 per month, which is \$29 per month over the Poverty Guidelines of \$1214 per month.

Basin City CDBG General Purpose Grant: Subrecipient Agreement with Basin City Water and Sewer District

<u>Motion</u> – Mr. Miller: Mr. Chairman, I'd like to move that we accept the Community Development Block Grant Subrecipient Agreement between Franklin County and Basin City Water and Sewer District for the Washington State Department of Community, Trade and Economic Development, Community Development Block Grant, in the amount of \$1,000,000. Second by Mr. Peck. 2:0 vote in favor. This is Resolution 2010-041.

PUBLIC WORKS (9:36 am)

Engineer Tim Fife met with the Board.

Public Hearing: Amend Six-Year Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP)

Public Hearing convened at 9:36 am. Present: Commissioners Peck and Miller; County Administrator Fred Bowen; Engineer Tim Fife; and Clerk to the Board Mary Withers. Present in audience: Kristy Pihl.

Mr. Fife explained the reason for the hearing. Mr. Peck said the proposed change to the TIP is because the East Foster Wells Road is ready to proceed and the county does not yet have some easements for other projects.

Because no one was present in the audience to comment, Mr. Peck closed the public hearing.

<u>Motion</u> – Mr. Miller: Mr. Chairman, I move we approve Resolution 2010-042 of the Board of Franklin County Commissioners in the matter of amending the six-year Transportation Improvement Program 2010-2016. Second by Mr. Peck. 2:0 vote in favor.

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Vouchers

<u>Motion</u> – Mr. Miller: I move that we accept 2009 vouchers for Solid Waste for \$367.22 and CR Unemployment Trust for \$2575.48, in the total amount of \$2942.70, and also the 2010 vouchers for County Road Fund for \$126,731.21, Solid Waste for \$355.00; and Motor Vehicle for \$17,908.23; for a grand total of \$144,994.44. Second by Mr. Peck. 2:0 vote in favor. (Exhibit 3)

Jed Crowther joined the audience.

County Road Project Information

Mr. Miller asked Mr. Fife to provide information regarding some county road projects before he travels to meetings in March.

Mr. Peck explained why travel by county commissioners benefits the county.

R170 Slide Area Bridge

Users of a bridge on R170 feel the bridge is too narrow. Mr. Fife said the bridge currently meets engineering standards. It is 20-some years old. The bridge could be retrofitted to become wider at an estimated cost of \$359,000 or replaced at an estimated cost of \$452,000. Mr. Fife recommended a third option, which is to remove the bridge and replace it with a pipe in cooperation with the irrigation district. He explained the work that would be involved.

Benton-Franklin Council of Governments (BFCOG) Stimulus 2 – Franklin County Process

<u>Update</u>

Mr. Fife gave a report on the discussions held with other entities regarding the proposal for projects using funds from the Federal Stimulus 2 program. The Board **gave approval** of the county's projects to be submitted on the proposal.
