WHEREAS, Franklin County is in temporary need of a part-time county road engineer and has requested the use of Malcolm Bowie, Benton County Engineer, on a part-time basis; and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.80.010 authorizes the county legislative body to contract with another county for the engineering services of a county road engineer from another county; and

WHEREAS, the Benton County Board of Commissioners deems it appropriate to enter into an agreement with Franklin County to provide engineering services on a part-time basis; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Benton and Franklin County Commissioners constitutes the legislative authority of their respective county and desires to enter into the arrangement; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, the Benton and Franklin County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the attached Interlocal Agreement for Provision of Engineering Services between County of Benton and County of Franklin, effective through April 30, 2012, and authorizes the Chairman to sign the Agreement on behalf of their respective county.

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR PROVISION OF ENGINEERING SERVICES BETWEEN COUNTY OF BENTON AND COUNTY OF FRANKLIN

THIS AGREEMENT is made on the $_$	6	day of	February	, 2012 by and	between
Franklin and Benton Counties, political					
referred to herein as "Counties"):					

WHEREAS, RCW 39.34 authorizes local governmental units to enter into agreements with other public agencies to make efficient use of their powers on a basis of mutual advantage to provide services to the local community; and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.80.010 states that the county legislative authority of each county shall employ a county road engineer on either a full-time or part time basis, or may contract with another county for the engineering services of a county road engineer from such other county; and

WHEREAS, Benton County has on a staff full time county road engineer; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County is temporarily in need of a part-time county road engineer to meet the requirements of RCW 36.80.010, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners for Franklin and Benton Counties have agree to enter into this agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefits of this agreement, the parties agree as follows:

1. It is the purpose of this agreement and agreed upon between the Counties of Franklin County shall be able to utilize Malcolm Bowie, Benton County Engineer for county road engineering and other Benton County Public Works staff as needed, as available and as approved by the Benton County Board of Commissioners on a part time basis as specified herein.

- 2. The duration of this agreement shall begin immediately upon the duly authorize signatures of both parties and shall expire on, or before, April 30, 2012.
- 3. Franklin County shall reimburse Benton County at the present hourly plus overhead per hour for professional engineering services provided by Malcolm Bowie and other Benton County Public Works staff, plus _51 \(\phi \) per mile for mileage. Any additional expenses shall be invoiced at cost with no additional mark up.
- 4. Benton County shall bill Franklin County by the 10th (tenth) of the month following the month in which costs were incurred. Franklin County will reimburse Benton County within 30 (thirty) days of billing for service.
- 5. Malcolm Bowie's duties shall include:
 - a. Examine and certify documents required by CRAB and WSDOT.
 - b. Review survey data within county right-of-way, cross sections and design projects.
 - c. Review plans, specifications, and engineering estimates.
 - d. Contract administration.
 - e. Project inspection.
 - f. Review and sign engineering section vouchers and payrolls
 - g. Any other county road engineer duties deemed necessary by Franklin County and Malcolm Bowie.
- 6. This agreement shall be in effect until April 30, 2012, unless terminated sooner, inwriting, by authorized representatives of either party. Either party may terminate this agreement at anytime for convenience as set forth herein this section.
- 7. Venue for any action hereunder shall be in Benton County, Washington. If any term of provision of this agreement is in whole or part, held invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this agreement shall continue in full force and effect.
- 8. Franklin County shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless Benton County, its officials, or agents and employees from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, judgments, or liabilities of whatever nature, including attorney fees, made by any person or entity as a result of Malcolm Bowie exercising his responsibilities of Franklin County, and any omissions related thereto, under the terms of this agreement.
- 9. This agreement does not contemplate the creation of a separate legal or administrative entity per RCW 39.34.030(3)(b).
- 10. All property provided by either party in the performance of this agreement shall remain that of the providing party and shall only be disposed of by said party.

11. The County Administrator of Benton County and the Chairman of the Franklin County Board County Commissioners shall serve as administrators and contract representatives for this agreement and all notices shall be delivered in writing to them at the following addresses:

For Franklin County: Attn: Franklin County Board County Commissioners, 3416 Stearman Avenue, Pasco, WA 99301

For Benton County: Attn: County Administrator, 620 Market Street, Prosser, WA 99350

In said capacity as administrators and contract representatives the County Administrators shall settle any and all disputes related to this agreement.

- 12. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties and may only be amended in writing by mutual agreement of the authorized representatives of the parties herein.
- 13. This agreement shall be effective upon the duly authorized signature of the parties' authorized representatives.
