Commissioners' Proceedings for November 6, 2013

The Honorable Board of Franklin County Commissioners met on the above date. Present for the meeting were Rick Miller, Chairman; Robert E. Koch, Chair Pro Tem; and Brad Peck, Member; Fred Bowen, County Administrator; and Margo Hines, Pro-Tem Clerk to the Board. Meeting convened at 9:00 am with the Pledge of Allegiance.

FRANKLIN COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 2

Public Hearing to take public comment on Franklin County Fire Protection District No. 2 Resolution No. 4-2013, a petition for withdrawal of territory from the fire protection district

Public Hearing convened at 9:00 am. Present: Commissioners Miller, Koch and Peck; County Administrator Fred Bowen; Pro-Tem Clerk to the Board Margo Hines; Fire District No. 3 Chief Les Litzenberger, Fire District No. 3 Assistant Fire Chief Ron Schuck, Connie Sherman, Ed Thornbrugh, Matt Mahoney, Dave Neff and Tri-City Herald Reporter Geoff Folsom.

Mr. Miller asked if anyone wished to give testimony. Dave Neff spoke in favor of the withdrawal of the area. He said the plan is to annex the area that is being withdrawn into Fire District No. 3.

Motion – Mr. Koch noted that the proper information has now been provided and moved for approval of findings of fact for withdrawal of the territory described from Fire District No. 2. Second by Mr. Peck. In response to Mr. Peck's question, Mr. Litzenberger said the Fire District No. 3 Board is willing to consider a petition to add the area to its district. 3:0 vote in favor. Resolution 2013-391 was approved.

retained a 20-foot easement for access to the river by pedestrians. In 1996 the county engineer

other side began encroaching as well. The landowners have petitioned for the area so they can
enjoy and maintain what they have constructed. Mr. Mahoney gave the Board information he

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had received about nearby public access from the Corps of Engineers. He answered the Board's questions.
