Commissioners' Proceedings for November 12, 2014

The Honorable Board of Franklin County Commissioners met on the above date. Present for the meeting were Robert E. Koch, Chairman; Brad Peck, Chair Pro Tem; and Rick Miller, Member; Fred Bowen, County Administrator; and Mary Withers, Clerk to the Board.

Meeting convened at 9:00 am with the Pledge of Allegiance.

CONSENT AGENDA DISCUSSION

Dear Mr. Fletcher,

On Thursday, June 20, 2013, the Franklin County Administrative Office received an email with attachment notifying the County of BNSF Railway's intention to close Russell Road from 4:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. on Monday, June 24, 2013, and Hailey Road from 4:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. on Tuesday, June 25, 2013. Each road was to be closed at the rail crossing. This notice came shortly after similar notice was delivered to the Public Works Department.

Pursuant to WAC 480-62-305, railroad companies, such as BNSF Railway, are required to give the governing authority of a local community written notice a minimum of ten (10) days prior to any planned action, including obstruction of a crossing. Additionally, the notice is required to include specific details about the work. None of these conditions were met in this instance.

As the governing authority for Franklin County it is imperative that the Board of Commissioners be informed of all potential road closures. As such all future notices should be directed to the Commissioner's Office and copied to the Public Works Department. Contact information is attached.

The County appreciates the relationship it has with BNSF Railway. However, given the burden such unexpected closures place on both the residents and staff of Franklin County, adherence to the requirements of the WAC is in the best interest of all parties. The Franklin County Board of Commissioners, in the strongest terms, urges compliance with these regulations on all subsequent activities.
