Commissioners' Proceedings for June 17, 2015

This document is a summarized version of the Board of Commissioners proceedings. The minutes are paraphrased, not verbatim. Access to an electronic audio recording of the meeting is available upon request.

The Honorable Board of Franklin County Commissioners met on the above date. Present for the meeting were Chairman Brad Peck, Chair Pro Tem Rick Miller, Commissioner Robert E. Koch, Interim County Administrator Jerrod MacPherson, and Clerk to the Board Valerie Loffler. The meeting convened at 9:00 a.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Meeting: Relating to CUP 2015-02 (Glotel, Inc.) (9:01 a.m.)

Following a staff report by Greg Wendt, Chairman Peck opened the public meeting at 9:09 a.m. No testimony was provided and the public meeting was closed.

<u>Motion:</u> Mr. Koch moved to adopt Resolution 2015-219 approving Conditional Use Permit 2015-02 subject to the six findings of fact and seven conditions of approval. Second by Miller. 3:0 vote in favor.

Bid Opening - Office Relocations (Moving) (9:12 a.m.)

Commissioner Bob Koch announced a single bid was received from Beacons Northwest in the amount of \$7,992.00.

Auditor Matt Beaton (9:15 a.m.)

Mr. Beaton responded to questions from the Board about project management services from Accent Business Services, Inc. They discussed using reserve funds, project progress, timeframes and staffing.

<u>Motion</u>: Commissioner Koch moved to approve the contract with Accent Business Services, Inc. and authorizing an Inter-Budget transfer of \$84,102.00 from the 2015 Current Expense Non-Departmental Budget 001-000-700, Line Item 597.00.00.0100 to the 2015 FC Capital Projects Fund Budget 300-000-001, Line Item 594.19.64.0001 to pay for services. Second by Mr. Miller. 3:0 in favor.

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Matt Mahoney, Public Works (9:40 a.m.)

Public Works Director Matt Mahoney provided a staff report requesting an inter-fund loan from the County Road Fund to the Motor Vehicle Fund.

Motion: Mr. Koch moved to approve Resolution 2015-221 authorizing an Inter-Fund Loan in the amount of \$310,000 from the 2015 Miscellaneous Expense County Road Fund, Number 150-000-001, to the 2015 Miscellaneous Expense Motor Vehicle Fund, Number 500-000-001; and Creation of Expenditure Line Item 581.10.00.0000 (I/F Loan/Motor Vehicle) within the 2015 Miscellaneous Expense County Road Fund, Number 150-000-001, and Revenue Line Item 381.10.00.0000 within the 2015 Miscellaneous Expense Motor Vehicle Fund, Number 500-000-001; and authorizing the Auditor to generate a warrant in the amount of \$310,000 from the 2015 Miscellaneous Expense County Road Fund, Number 150-000-001. Second by Mr. Miller. 3:0 in favor.

Mr. Mahoney discussed the amendment to the Major Equipment Purchases adopted by Resolution 2014-468.

<u>Motion:</u> Mr. Koch moved to approve Resolution 2015-222, authorizing amendment to 2015 Major Equipment Purchases adopted by Resolution 2014-468. Second by Mr. Miller. 3:0 in favor.

Mr. Mahoney also discussed road maintenance and status of the Juniper Dunes access.
