PUBLIC COMMENTS

Ms.Vicki Contini, Washington State University retiree, and long time Franklin county resident, expressed her concern with issues regarding Peterson Road. She stated approximately forty-two (42) homes use Peterson Road as the only access to town. This winter the road had become so damaged by the rains, vehicles were getting stuck in the mud and ruts. A Petition was brought submitted with names of homeowners that have a complaint with the upkeep of Peterson Road.



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This road is a Private Road owned by a farmer/landowner and he has tried to maintain the road but maintenance if overwhelming. Ms. Contini asked the Board if there was anything the County could do to help resolve this issue.

Commissioner Peck explained Peterson Road is not a County Road so the County does not have the right to maintain it at this time. He said he would research the issue to determine if there were options for the homeowners with their concerns. He thanked Ms. Contini for coming and representing the public.

COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR KEITH JOHNSON

• Bi-County Superior Court Agreement: County Administrator Keith Johnson met with the Benton County Deputy Administrator regarding a preliminary offer suggesting the renegotiation of administrative fees, additional VEBA contributions and information technology services for Bi-County Superior Court employees. He explained Benton County was currently contributing to those employee's VEBA accounts but Franklin County is not contributing. He felt it was appropriate to continue discussion of bi-county negotiations.

After discussion, it was decided Mr. Johnson would suggest a third party to negotiate any additional fees affiliated with Bi-County Superior Court employees.
