CALL TO ORDER

Commission Chairman, Rick Miller called the Franklin County Commissioners' Regular Board Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Franklin County Courthouse located at 1016 North Fourth Avenue, Pasco, Washington.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Commissioner Miller led the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC MEETING

Zoning Designation Change from Residential Transition and Residential Suburban 40,000 to Residential Suburban 20,000 (not approved)

Director of Planning and Building Jerrod Macpherson presented the Board with a Zone Change recommendation for approximately 198 acres of land located in the City of Pasco Urban Growth Boundary. A power point presentation of the location and use of the land was given. After discussion of road access to a possible new residential development adjoining Kohler road, the board recommended that the Planning Department revise the document and re-submit it in a closed record hearing.

CUP 2016-02 - A Conditional Use Permit Application to Utilize an Existing Accessory Building as an Accessory Dwelling Unit (not approved)

Assistant Planning Director Greg Wendt presented the Board with a proposed Conditional Use Permit application request to utilize an existing historic rock dwelling on the property as an accessory dwelling unit for an aged parent. After brief discussion, the Board requested that the Planning Department review the historic information and redefine the scope to preserve and protect this dwelling. This is to be brought back to the board after revisions have been made.

APRIL 20, 2016

Discussion of Creation of Line Item in 2016 Budget for Coroner's Inquest Resolution 2016-166

Coroner Dan Blasdel presented the Board with budget request for the Inquest. Mr. Blasdel was stated that (CBC) Columbia Basin College has extended their facilities as a place to hold the inquest.

* Commissioner Peck made the motion to approve the Inter Budget Transfer of \$25,123.00 from the 2016 Current Expense Non-Departmental to the Current Expense Coroner's Budget. Commissioner Koch seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Columbia-Snake River Irrigators Association, Presentation by Board Representative Darryll Olsen, Ph.D.

Private sector financing and development for Odessa Subarea surface water deliver from the East Low Canal. Private sector irrigators and major land owners in the Odessa Subarea have been blocked by the ECB/USBR from receiving new water service contracts for the East Low Canal. This reflects both extraordinarily poor public sector management and a 20th Century mindset ill-suited for 21st Century irrigation development. Water would have been "on the ground" this spring, if the privates had been allowed to proceed; and the renewed call for more state/federal subsidies is nonsense and will only further delay water system development.

After Mr. Olsen's remarks, the Board asked several more questions about the background of the Odessa situation. Commissioner Miller thanked Mr. Olsen for coming in and informing the Board of his view of the Irrigation problems.
