# **ADMINISTRATION OFFICE BUSINESS**

- County Administrator Keith Johnson explained there is a tentative agreement to have Crisis Health Services transfer assets to Lourdes and Benton County and Franklin County staff continue to work on an agreement for Benton County to release partial ownership of Detox Facility in Pasco to Franklin County.
- o Mr. Johnson stated the Farris litigation had concluded and the County would be issuing payment to the appropriate parties once approved by the Commissioner. He presented the Commissioners with **Resolution 2016-350** approving negotiated payment of attorney's fees, expert witness fees and bill of costs explaining the Resolution resolved all past, present and future claims against the County.

Commissioner Peck noted this situation had not occurred under the current Sheriff's administration.

Commissioner Peck moved to approve Resolution 2016-350 approving negotiated payments of attorney's fees, expert witness fess and bill of costs. Commissioner Koch seconded and the motion carried.

- o Mr. Johnson announced the roll out OneSolution payroll had been completed in Public Works and anticipated remaining departments to also have a successful payroll launch in the near future.
- o Mr. Johnson announced Facilities Manager Jennifer Wagner had received notification of a potential grant from the Washington State Legislature for the preservation for the maintenance of the interior of the Historical Courthouse. If the grant is approved by the State, funding would be disbursed in June of 2017.
