#### RECLASSIFICATION OF CHIEF DEPUTY CORONER

Human Resources Director Carlee Nave presented the Board with more information concerning the Chief Deputy Coroner salary increase as a follow up from the last Commissioners' Meeting. As of November 22, 2017 a Federal Judge in Texas put a hold on the decision to uphold the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) salary thresholds change that would take effect December 1, 2016. The Human Resources still recommends proceeding with the reclassification of the Chief Deputy Coroner Position as presented.

## ADDITIONAL FUNDING REQUEST FOR SUPERIOR COURT

Benton-Franklin County Court Administrator Pat Austin requested additional funds for Superior Court due to the unusually large number of high profile cases which require extensive interpretation. These Professional Services are a direct result of insufficient funds for the current year. The State does reimburse some of the funds but it is a slow process.

Commissioner Peck moved to approve Resolution 2016-438 interbudget transfer of \$44,000 from 2016 current expense non-departmental to Superior Court \$27,000 Court reimbursement Benton County and \$17,000 to Superior Court Adult Drug Court and interbudget transfer of \$10,000 from 2016 current expense non-departmental to

Mr. Clint Didier asked for a copy of the proposed 2017 budget. He also asked the Public Works department not to touch his barrow pit as it has been sprayed for tack weeds. The barrow pit has been disrupted and Mr. Didier will now need to spray again.
