# DESIGNATE SIGNATORY AUTHORITY FOR FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION GRANTS

Public Works Director Matt Mahoney and County Engineer Craig Erdman presented the Board with a choice of three resolutions to expedite the process of obtaining Federal Highway Grants.

- Resolution 2016-449 would designate the Chairman of the Board to have Signatory Authority
- Resolution 2016-450 would designate the Public Works Director to have Signatory Authority
- Resolution 2016-451 would designate the County Administrator to have Signatory Authority

After brief discussion and wanting to remain transparent in all actions taken, the Board agreed to designate the County Administrator to have Signatory Authority for Federal Highway Administration Grant's annual and final fiscal reports as well as vouchers requesting reimbursement payments of behalf of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners.

Commissioner Peck seconded and the motion carried.

# SHERIFF NEW SALARY SCHEDULE PLACEMENT

Human Resources Director Carlee Nave presented the Board with the change of Sheriff's salary to the Sheriff's Non-bargaining salary matrix.

When the County implemented the Hay Study, the salary for the Sheriff was set by resolution 2007-264 at Grade 22, Step 7 of the Non-Bargaining Salary Matrix (currently \$104,976 annually). Other non-bargaining positions within the Sheriff's Office including the Undersheriff and Captain were placed, and remain today, on the Sheriff's Non-Bargaining salary matrix.

The Sheriff is requesting for the Sheriff's position salary to be set on the Sheriff's Non-Bargaining salary matrix at a Grade S21, Step 7 (currently \$110,694) which is one Grade higher than the Undersheriff and Corrections Administrator. Having the Sheriff's position on a different matrix than the rest of his non-bargaining staff has resulted in concerns the salary of the Sheriff is was only 4% higher than the Undersheriff. Placement of the Sheriff at S21, Step 7 would result in a 10% above the top step Undersheriff.

There is an administrative benefit to having all of the Sheriff's non-bargaining positions, including the Sheriff, on the same salary matrix.

\* Commissioner Koch moved to approve Resolution 2016-452 Sheriff New Salary Schedule Placement. Commissioner Miller seconded.

After discussion the motion was withdrawn and the item (Resolution 2016-452) was tabled to a future meeting pending additional information.

Testimony Regarding the 2017 Franklin County Budget

Commissioner Miller recessed into a Public Hearing at 10:02 a.m., to hear testimony regarding the 2017 Franklin County Budget.

Director of Finance Thomas C. Westerman gave the Board an overview of the budget. A few of the items discussed were expenditures, contingencies and reserves, salaries, staffing, settlements and criminal justice.

As of December 1, 2016 the County will have paid the last payment for the 1995 remodel of the Juvenile Justice Center.

Coroner Dan Blasdel asked the Commissioners about his budget request for a camera, computer and travel expenses. After brief discussion it was noted the budget submitted by the Coroner did not contain accurate information and the Commissioners and Administrator would need to review the correct information before making a final decision.

After brief discussion the Commissioners stated the budget needed further review before approval and anticipated approving the 2017 budget at the next Regular Commissioners' Meeting scheduled for December 14, 2017.

Commissioner Miller asked for public comment. Having none, Commissioner Miller closed the Public Hearing and reconvened the Regular meeting at 10:28 a.m.
