CALL TO ORDER

Commission Chairman Robert Koch called the Franklin County Commissioners' Regular Board Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Franklin County Courthouse located at 1016 North Fourth Avenue, Pasco, Washington.

LEGISLATIVE REPRESENTATION OLYMPIA

Mr. Jim Potts and Mr. Zac Kennedy gave a brief review of week three of the legislative session.

Mr. Kennedy explained there were a lot of water bills on the list and the Hirst decision is still a main topic that is being closely watched. There is no way to know where the discussion and policy will end up over the next few weeks but the legislature is committed to alleviating the confusion caused by the court decision.

Firearms legislation has been another big topic of discussion this session. There are bills on both sides of the issue, more and less regulation, some of the bills are moving along but getting any of them through both houses will prove difficult.

Mr. Kennedy stated he was starting to see wildfire bills to clarify and enhance the ability of locals to mobilize and fight fire in the rural areas.

With both houses sitting at a nearly perfect split, moving legislation this year will be slow and difficult. Finding sponsorship for bills this year has been a challenge as well so it would seem that the legislators are not too interested in moving legislation quickly.

Since there are a large amount of bills being submitted, Mr. Kennedy asked the Commissioners to review the list of current bills and prioritize which ones they would like to have him follow.

ADMINISTRATION OFFICE BUSINESS

- Benton-Franklin Counties Human Services Director Kyle Sullivan gave the Board an
 update on the Mental Health Services progress. Mr. Sullivan has spoken with Lourdes
 and the transition of services is going well. One position remains to be filled at this time.
 - The contract with Leon Evans is still being negotiated. Mr. Sullivan will meet with Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Timothy Dickerson and review information pertaining to this matter and report back to the Board on February 8, 2017 with his findings.
- Franklin County Voluntary Stewardship Program (VSP) is making progress towards their written plan. The last meeting was well-attended including such groups as Farm Bureau, Audubon Society, and Potato Growers, as well as others. The VSP group continues to move forward with the work and solve problems as they arise.

 Administrator Keith Johnson, Sheriff Jim Raymond, Commander Steve Sultemeier, and KMB Architects toured the Correctional Center this week and reviewed items that needed to be repaired and/or modified.

Mr. Johnson and Sheriff Raymond are keeping requirements of litigation in mind as they prioritize changes that need to occur. Mr. Johnson is in the process of estimating the expenses and finding funding to move this project forward. The project should be complete or nearly completed by September 2018 to comply with requirements.
