County Administrator Keith Johnson updated the Commissioners on the information that was gathered by the County Engineer in regards to the speeding problem on Wernett Road. Public Works Director Matt Mahoney and County Engineer Craig Erdman have suggested installing a solar powered speed sign. This has proved to be an effective tool in other areas and would not pose an additional problem that speed bumps could bring to the area. Sheriff Raymond will work with the Mr. Mahoney on the placement of both signs.
