## WASHINGTON COUNTIES RISK POOL

Executive Director Derek Bryan presented the Board with some trends, options and assessments of Risk Pool.

Under RCW 48.62 "... exclusive source of local government authority to individually or jointly self-insure risks, jointly purchase insurance or reinsurance, and to contract for risk management, claims, and administrative services."

- 1988 WCRP forms with 15 members (including Franklin County).
- Current Membership: 26 Counties
- Risk Pool is governed by Board of Directors, Executive Committee, Investment Committee, and Standing Committees
- County Appointed Positions include a Claims Administrator and Risk Manager
- WCRP's Operational Structure consists of Administration and Finance, Claims and Member Services

Mr. Bryan reviewed the different charts in regards to the finances, assessments and claims in relation to the 26 Counties involved. He also shared the breakdown of data for Franklin County in comparison to other Counties. Data has been collected from the past 4 years and this information has given us the ratio to figure the costs for Franklin County. Rates have increased dramatically due to the claims that have been submitted over this 4 year period of time.

\* All Commissioners were in consensus as to the added extra five million dollars in coverage, and going with the twenty-five million dollar deductable.
