## FRANKLIN COUNTY BENEFITS ADMINISTRATION POLICY

Human Resources Director Carlee Nave presented the Board with a proposed update to the Benefits Administration policy that was adopted in 2011. Over time, the policy has proven inadequate in addressing the breadth of administrative concerns inherent in the administration of benefits plans, particularly in a dynamic legislative landscape. All Department Heads have had an opportunity to review this policy and give their input on the matter. This policy will be reviewed annually to ensure continued legal compliance as well as compliance with carrier requirements.
