ORDINANCE 1-2018 ZONE CHANGE 2017-02 TO DESIGNATE 20.4 ACRES NEAR ELTOPIA WITH RC-5 ZONING

Planning and Building Director Loren Wiltse presented the Board with Ordinance 1-2018. Mr. Wiltse reviewed the documents with the Commissioners and discussed the request of the zone change and the conditions that would apply to this ordinance.

* Commissioner Miller moved to approve Ordinance 1-2018, Zone Change 2017-02 to designate 20.4 acres near Eltopia with RC-5 zoning. Commissioner Koch seconded with discussion. After brief discussion the motion carried.

CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 2017-03 TO CONSTRUCT A NEW MULTIPURPOSE BUILDING FOR CHURCH RELATED USE

Planning and Building Director Loren Wiltse presented the Board with a Conditional Use Permit 2017-03 to construct a new multipurpose building for Church related use. Originally, the applicant also indicated they wanted to establish a school on the site. However, that request was withdrawn and therefore no Conditional Use Permit for school use is granted. There was a brief discussion on parking lot standards, fire alarm system plans and county road codes.
