PUBLIC HEARING

Testimony Regarding Amendment #1 to the Franklin County's Transportation Improvement Plan 2018-2023

Public Works Director Matt Mahoney gave a brief background of the Transportation Improvement Program Amendment.

On June 28, 2017, the Board of Franklin County Commissioners approved Franklin County's transportation improvement plan for 2018-2023 (Resolution 2017-179). Since the adoption of the TIP in June, the plan will need to be amended to add projects due to a recent call-for-projects or project scheduling issues.

2018-2023 TIP recommended changes include:

CRP 615 - Smith Canyon Bridge #722-0.07 Replacement \$15,000
 Hailey Road Railroad Crossing Improvement \$105,555
