#### CALL TO ORDER

Commission Chairman Brad Peck called the Franklin County Commissioners' Regular Board Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Franklin County Courthouse located at 1016 North Fourth Avenue, Pasco, Washington.

#### LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Jim Potts and Zac Kennedy presented the Board with a few legislative updates.

- Senate bill 5992 relating to bump-fire stock passed
- ATV bills did not pass
- Carbon tax bill was dropped for 2018 year
- Indigent defense funding was discussed

#### WSU EXTENSION UPDATE ON REGIONAL FORAGE PROGRAMMING

Forage & Irrigated Cropping Systems Regional Specialist Steve Norberg, Ph.D.

Three main extension programmatic areas are listed as:

- Alfalfa variety trials provide the best information possible for variety selection for hay production.
- Forage nutrient management creates guidelines and tools for timothy fertility, especially nitrogen.
- Improved forage systems decrease the cost of producing forages and/or increase the value per acre. Alternative forages are included in this as well.

There are 20 major Seed Cooperators that participate in the seed trials. The Alfalfa seeds used in the trials are rated for the quality of fiber, energy and crude protein content.

Washington State Hay Growers Association (WSHGA) and Dr. Norberg are dedicated to research, nurturing, and growing the hay industry not only in the Pacific Northwest but throughout the entire world.

Dr. Norberg is also working with Struvite to improve the soil for forage producers. There is a mobile nutrient recovery system that is presently being used at dairies around the area.

#### RECLASSIFICATION of PLANNING and BUILDING DIRECTOR

Human Resources Director Carlee Nave presented the Board with a proposal of reclassification of Planning and Building Director position. The Planning & Building Director position is currently placed on the Exempt and 7.5 Hour Non-Exempt Non-Bargaining Seven Step Matrix at a Grade 20. The County Administrator and Public Works Director requested a compensation review of the position based on the competitive nature of the labor market. Human Resources have conducted a market evaluation and recommends the position be placed at a Grade 21.
