10:00 AM Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

Commission Chairman Brad Peck called the Franklin County Commissioners' Regular Board Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Franklin County Courthouse located at 1016 North Fourth Avenue, Pasco, Washington.

10:02 AM Washington State Association of Counties (WSAC) - Executive Director Eric Johnson reported on the 2018 Annual Courthouse briefings.

Every May for the past 10 years, leaders of the Washington State Association of Counties have met to set goals, establish action, and chart strategies to advance the business and policy agenda for the Association. In recent years, WSAC members began to explore more assertive actions to both communicate the challenges facing county government and identify other bold actions, including increased communication, civil disobedience, and litigation, to advance the WSAC Policy Agenda.

Mr. Eric Johnson discussed the 2018 Strategic Litigation and Communications (SLAC) Program, which seeks help from the state on specific proposals and solutions to provide financial relief for counties including:

- Changes in laws to help counties control costs
- Additional revenue capabilities
- Flexibility with existing revenue
- Additional state shared revenues to perform state required services

A few of the unfunded state mandates include additional ballot boxes and indigent defense in counties.

Mr. Eric Johnson briefly spoke on the Healthcare transition as different counties start to adjust their program to adhere to the state requirements.
