9:02 AM Proposed Text Amendment to the Franklin County Code

AHBL Personal Services Contractor Nicole Stickney presented the proposed text amendment to the Franklin County Code, Title 16 Subdivisions, Chapter 16.20 Preliminary Plat, Section 16.20.030 Preliminary plat application, Chapter 16.24 Final Plat, Section 16.24.010 Application and Section 16.24.020 Final plat preparation, Chapter 16.32 Short Subdivisions, Section 16.32.070 Final review, approval and filing and Section 16.32.040 Application — Content, Chapter 16.32 Binding Site Plans, Section 16.36.090 Approval and filing and Section 16.32.110 Standards for binding site plans pertaining to the number of copies required for applications and the submittal of materials for final recording.
