9:02 AM Proposed Franklin County Leave Transfer Policy

The proposed Leave Transfer Policy is intended to update and clarify the administration of the existing program adopted in 2009 as the Policy on Voluntary Transfer of Annual Leave. In the course of updating the policy, research revealed that the existing policy did not fully conform to IRS requirements, leaving the employee donating leave hours vulnerable to a potential tax liability for the hours transferred. In this update, we have addressed the gaps in the existing policy as well as clarifying the administration of the policy to help with better employee and manager understanding of the program. This proposed policy update does not fundamentally change the leave donation program.
