

9:04 AM Administration Office Business

- County Administrator Keith Johnson presented Resolution 2018-279 and read the changed language in the document.
 - a. Whereas, the Lease require the written consent of the Board of Commissioner of Franklin County is necessary to assign rights under the lease.
 - b. RCCH Healthcare, an affiliate of Capella Healthcare for a period not to exceed the earlier of the approval of a new lease agreement between the parties or June 20, 2019.

The Board approved the language changes. However, Commissioner Peck has concerns about the dollar amount attached to the agreement, as the new Leases' are a private for profit entity. His concern is someone may misconstrue the below market cost of lease as gifting. Commissioner Peck sees it as an exchange of goods and services for the citizens of Franklin County, until a new lease rate is established and the agreement implemented.

- * Commissioner Koch moved to approve Resolution 2018-279, Assigning Lease and Amendment Extending Lease Term with Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital to RCCH Healthcare Partners, an Affiliate of Capella Healthcare for Property Located at 210 and 224 North 7th in Pasco, Washington known as "Wilson House". Commissioner Peck seconded and the motion carried.
- Mr. Johnson brought forth a Joint County Authority of Administrative Services Organization (ASO) Interlocal Operating Agreement of Greater Columbia Behavioral Health (GCBH), LLC. document.

Commissioner Koch stated that this document would act as a stopgap and allow GCBH to carry on business until January 1, 2019, at which time the new Administrative Services Organization would sign a new contract.

Commissioner Koch contacted Human Services Director Kyle Sullivan by phone and he briefed the Board that the LLC would act as interim status until the first of the year.

After discussion, Commissioner Peck asked Mr. Sullivan to add a termination clause to the proposed document and bring it before the Board next week.

 Mr. Johnson presented Resolution 2018-282, Memorandum of Understanding with Altered Image Films. The Film Company would like to use part of the Courthouse as a set for a portion of their movie.

* Commissioner Koch moved to approve Resolution 2018-282, a Memorandum of Understanding with Altered Image Films, Commissioner Peck seconded and the motion carried.
