Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

Commission Chairman Brad Peck called the Franklin County Commissioners' Regular Board Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Franklin County Courthouse located at 1016 North Fourth Avenue, Pasco, Washington.

October 2, 2018 Commissioners' Meeting Minutes approved as presented.

9:03 AM Opening of Proposals for the Inmate Medical Services in Corrections Center Sheriff Raymond explained that there were three proposals. Two of the proposals withdrew, leaving one proposal. Commissioner Peck asked for an update during the following meeting.

9:03 AM Franklin County Noxious Weed Control Board Budget 2019

Program Coordinator Todd Harris reviewed the 2019 Noxious Weed Control Budget with the Commissioners. Commissioner Peck asked if the salary increase and changes were appropriate. Human Resources Director Carlee Nave informed the Board that Mr. Harris did work with Human Resources to set salaries as presented.

Commissioner Miller moved to approve Resolution 2018-313 Franklin County Noxious Weed Control Board Budget for 2019. Commissioner Koch seconded and the motion carried.

9:15 AM 2019 Employee Benefits Presentation- Conover Insurance

Conover Insurance Representative Dave Guyll and Human Resources Generalist Eric Wyant presented a Power Point presentation on the 2019 Employee Benefits information gathered by the Benefits Committee over several months.

Mr. Guyll discussed the renewal rate information and options that were available to County employees. The Benefits Committee reviewed the options and posted a countywide survey for employees to fill out to assist in the recommendation to the Board.

Human Resources staff requested Board consensus with regard to rate structure and additional benefits in order to move forward with preparation for 2019 Open Enrollment. The Benefits Committee recommends the Board adopt a 2-tier rate structure and add Life-Flight as a benefit offering for the 2019 plan year.

 Commissioner Koch moved to accept 2-tier rate with an option of Life-Flight services available to employees. Commissioner Miller seconded and the motion carried.
