Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

Commission Chairman Robert Koch called the Franklin County Commissioners' Regular Board Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Franklin County Courthouse located at 1016 North Fourth Avenue, Pasco, Washington.

9:01 AM Public Comment

Citizen Rebecca Hissam provided a comment to oppose the Sub Plat 2018-24 Lot Dimension Deviation Request. Ms. Hissam lives directly across from the proposed lots and stated that in 2014 they abided by the codes when they sub-divided their parcel. They did this because not only was it code, but that they liked living in a more rural area and the buyers of the newly sub-divided parcel did as well. Ms. Hissam does not see a precedence of deviating from the code to a 90-foot frontage, and asked the Board to deny the request.

Jamie Bacon purchased a subdivided parcel from Rebecca Hissam to get away from the tightly spaced homes in which she lived in off of Road 100. Ms. Bacon agreed with Ms. Hissam's statements, and would like to keep the neighborhood with the same standard County code of 120-foot or more of frontage per parcel.

Aaron Huckleberry lives across the street from the proposed deviation property and echoes the same feelings as Ms. Hissam and Ms. Bacon. Mr. Huckleberry also stated his concern with congestion of the area with more cars parked on the street. He does not see the precedence or need to waiver the County code on these proposed lots. Mr. Huckleberry asked the Board to deny this request.
