9:03 a.m. Young Adult Housing Program

Human Services Director Kyle Sullivan informed the Board of the Young Adult Housing program he would like to implement in Benton and Franklin Counties. He recently attended a statewide meeting with the Department of Commerce and other agencies where they discussed continuum care. They identified a large gap in youth homelessness. Youth who are going to school and turn eighteen are no longer eligible to stay at My Friends Place and would need to go to elsewhere. This also affects the youth in foster homes. There are schools that collaborate with the youth and help them with job and career placement support. This program would allow youth who age out of an existing home, the opportunity to transition into adulthood without becoming homeless.

Mr. Sullivan received a consensus from the Franklin County Board to move forward with this program. All Commissioners were in agreement.
