#### Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

Commission Chairman Robert Koch called the Franklin County Commissioners' Regular Board Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Franklin County Courthouse located at 1016 North Fourth Avenue, Pasco, Washington.

#### 9:01 a.m. Approval of Minutes

August 20, 2019 Commissioners' Meeting Minutes approved as presented.

9:01 a.m. Washington State University Extension Update on Viticulture and Tree Fruit Gwen-Alyn Hoheisel, WSU Extension Tree Fruit & Viticulture Specialist was unable to attend today's meeting. WSU Extension Director Tim Waters introduced the newest WSU extension facility member Dr. Emmanuel Osafo. He will be over the Benton Franklin 4-H and Gardening Programs.

Dr. Osafo introduced himself and gave a background of his education. He is from Ghana and received his degree in psychology from the University of Ghana. He continued his education at Missouri State University and the University of Minnesota where he obtained his PhD.

He came to Kennewick in August and is analyzing the needs of the programs he oversees. By doing this, he can evaluate the needs of the programs and develop steps to improve the effectiveness and enhance the program to benefit the community.

Mr. Waters talked about the cabbage looper moth and armyworms as current pests in fields. Also, Gwen-Alyn Hoheisel is finding the lethal phylloxera in vineyards that kills the plant.

#### 9:12 a.m. Update on the 0.09 Funding

Port of Pasco Director of Economic Development Gary Ballew is also the chair elect for the Washington Economic Development Association. A bill was proposed earlier this year in legislation that could impact the 0.09 funds.

The bill extends authority to border counties that will primarily affect Spokane and Clark counties. It will also assist Benton and Whatcom counties in the renewal, as they are no longer considered rural, but are included as they are bordering counties. For the remaining counties, it will extend these funds from 2034 to 2045. There will be guidance from many different groups as the amended bill goes through legislation.

#### 9:22 a.m. Tuition Reimbursement Policy

Human Resources Director Carlee Nave presented a background for the tuition reimbursement policy. This policy was adopted in 1994 and funding came from individual department budgets. In 2019 budget, a line item was created in the Non-Departmental budget for this benefit, and a modernized policy is the next step in the enhancement of this benefit program. Discussion on the requirements and reasoning behind the policy ensued.
