9:01 a.m. Discussion on Substitute House Bill 1406 - Affordable Housing Sales Tax Credit

Human Services Director Kyle Sullivan gave a background of the Substitute House Bill 1406. The bill authorizes the governing body of a city or county to impose a local sales and use tax for the acquisition construction or rehabilitation of affordable housing or facilities providing supportive housing and for the operations and maintenance costs of affordable or supportive housing. Franklin County has a population less than 400,000, which makes rental assistance another eligible expense.

A letter of intent is to be signed by the County no later than January 2020 if they would like to participate. Actual adoption of the program must take place prior to July 2020.
