  - Commissioner Didier moved to approve the Consent Agenda. Commissioner Peck seconded with discussion. Commissioner Peck thanked Public Works for their work with other entities. The motion carried.

#### 9:03 a.m. Administration Office Business

- Administrator Keith Johnson briefed the Board on the retirement of Deputy Ruben Bayona and thanked him for his 19 years of service to the county.
- Mr. Johnson reiterated that the county was open for business even with the reduction of
  public contact. He urged the public to continue to use social distancing. He is continuing
  to work with the Auditor and the Treasurer in regards to financial matters, and will continue
  to modify the budget accordingly.
- With the request from the CDC to wear protective masks, we are giving PPE Personal Protective Equipment (masks) to those employees who interact with the public. We have already donated the majority of our PPE to the local hospital.
- Commissioner Koch confirmed that schools are shut down for the rest of the school year. Possible closure into the fall as well.
- Commissioner Didier expressed his concerns about potato crop contracts being canceled
  and farmers not able to produce crops. He would like to send a letter to Governor Inslee to
  open up Eastern Washington.
- Mr. Johnson updated the Commissioners on the Governors orders to cease building until
  further notice. The Builders may continue to secure and protect homes from damage that
  can be caused by weather, but needs to refrain from further building.
- Commissioner Peck stated it was inconclusive on whether high temperatures kill Covid-19. He thanked Jeff Losey, Home Builders Association Executive Director and his work on helping the building community. He was not on board with sending a letter to Governor Inslee as there are highly dense areas in Eastern Washington.
- Commissioner Didier had concerns with the inconsistency of restrictions. He did not understand why the transit was still running. Commissioner Koch stated that Ben Franklin Transit services have been drastically cut, however the public still has a need for transportation to doctor's appointments and other essential necessities.
