- Roger Lenk is supportive of a Recovery Center, just not the one being proposed by the Kennewick Public/Twin Rivers Hospital District. He read a background of the reasons he believed supported his position
- Donna Raymond asked the Commissioners to get Franklin County open for business.
   She commended Commissioner Didier as a private citizen for his efforts to open the county.
- George Dockstader appreciated the Board's effort to reopen the county. He would like
  the Commissioners to look into cutting county expenses.
- Jack Bunger had concerns about opening construction.
- Michelle Andres has organized a rolling rally on May 9, 2020 at 10 a.m. to legally protest and call on Governor Inslee to re-open Washington State.
- Commissioner Peck read RCW 43.06.220 State of emergency- Powers of governor. The
  "Stay- at- home" extension was signed by the four corners of state government. Regardless
  of how we feel, the Commissioners do not have power override the Governor to open the
  county.
- Commissioner Didier some businesses have already gone out of business. He is concerned
  with a Governor who has overreached his constitutional boundaries. Attorney General
  William Barr would support us standing up to the Governor.
- Michelle Andres looked into the bill and no one saw how much power this gave a governor. We as a people need to stand up and be heard.
- Jack Bunger asked what defines existing construction. Administrator Keith Johnson mentioned that the Governors website would have answers.
- George Dockstader stated that according to the governor, if a permit has not been given, it is not existing construction.
