• Administrator Keith Johnson reported that the State Board of Health received Franklin County's Phase 2 application and was denied to due to the increase of COVID numbers.

#### 9:23 a.m. Public Comment

- Jason Schlegal supported contact tracing and asked that everyone work together to decrease
  the COVID in our area. He also voiced his concerns with leaders and asked for civility
  when conducting county business.
- Anonymous letter voiced concerns and opposed the Fourth of July event.
- Steve Simmons is greatly concerned with the Governors actions and harming the county and the state with the lengthy emergency mandates. He opposed opening by phases and would like public input how they would like to proceed.
- Lawanda Hatch acknowledged that retrieval of data from labs is obtainable. She voiced her concern on the lack of incomplete or partial data.
- George Dockstader suggested purchasing ambulances with the CARES funding instead of giving to Public Health. He was concerned with wasting taxpayer's money with implementing rumble strips.
- Commissioner Didier asked Mr. Johnson to clarify an email of contact tracers from the
  courthouse to help the Health Department until the health department hires others for this
  position. The CARES act will fund this service.
- Commissioner Peck asked the Health Department to update their webpage and they have done so.
