#### 9:04 a.m. Administration Office Business

 County Administrator Keith Johnson discussed the CARES ACT and the five million dollars that would go to Franklin County to pay for COVID 19 expenses. Most of the monies would go to the Health Department to provide for Personal Protective Equipment. Franklin County would receive these funds once a contract was signed with the Department of Commerce.

Promotional means are being used to encourage the usage of masks and social distancing, to lessen the spread of the virus. There are concerns that hospitals are stressed and close to limits with those who are infected in the county.

- Governor Inslee will visit the Tri-Cities today and speak at Columbia Basin College. It is by invitation only and Franklin County Administrator was not invited and did not know who was invited.
- Commissioner Didier did not get an invitation to attend Governor Inslee's meeting. He
  asked if any of the other Commissioners were invited. Commissioner Koch said, he was
  invited as Commissioner Chair, and would be attending.
- Commissioner Didier was concerned that the signs for Health Department were not bilingual and suggested to add Spanish language to it.
- Commissioner Didier had concerns with the Health Department Facebook page posting
  promotional groups. The Health Department should not use this page as a political arena.
  Commissioner Peck concurred with Commissioner Didier on the matter and has discussed
  this with the Health Director to omit posting items that could be perceived as political.
