- Mr. Johnson announced that the Budget Hearing would be held December 8, 2020.
- Commissioner Didier asked for an update on the status of the finances in Franklin County. Mr. Johnson reported that the Franklin County's budget was close to what he estimated during the first of the year. Departments are managing their expenses responsibly. We are under budget on our spending and over budget on our revenues. There continues to be major growth with building in Franklin County. This year looks positive, however, Mr. Johnson was concerned about long-term impacts to the upcoming year. He will distribute a draft 2021 budget to the Commissioners this week.
