 Pastor Vlad Savchuk of Hungry Generation established a 501C3 VSM Charity to collect funds for humanitarian assistance for refugees who have fled Ukraine. They wish to receive and assist the refugees. He asked if the Franklin County Commissioners would submit an application to Washington State of Commerce to grant assistance, which is available for this purpose.

All Commissioners were in consensus to support this application.

- Lawanda Hatch wanted to know if there were rules in place for county employees and car accidents. Roberts Rules is about respect.
- Sheriff Jim Raymond requested copies of Roberts Rules and copies of the rules established in 1883 and give them to the Board. He suggested moving forward by getting along and doing county business.
 - The county does have vehicle accident policies.
- George Dockstader voiced his concern over the decision made last week regarding the Auditor's vehicle accident. He mentioned the remaining 4.5 million ARPA funds should go into the general fund for lost profits.
